Summer has arrived, and while our retreat schedule has eased slightly, we're still keeping busy with some exciting campus improvements!

Cross Replacement Project

One major project already underway is the replacement of the cross

in our front yard. As many of you know, the original structure was actually a repurposed telephone pole dating back to the 1960s. The beautiful Corpus was added in the early 2000s, bringing a more sacred presence to the space.

This summer, we're:

Carefully removing the Corpus


- · Construction of a brand-new, redesigned cross
- · Reinstalling the Corpus on the new structure

We're grateful to Dean Dwyer, who has designed the new cross, is overseeing its construction, and is managing the entire project.

Driveway & Parking Lot Improvements

We're also exploring improvements to our entry driveway and parking lot. Currently, there are two narrow "choke points" that restrict traffic to a single lane. To improve access, we're gathering proposals to:

- Widen the driveway at these pinch points (highlighted in green, yellow, and blue)
- Repair a damaged section of the parking lot where the asphalt has broken up (red)

If we receive a reasonable proposal, we plan to move forward with the work, which would be funded through our operating budget.





Serra Club to Hold Annual Priest Appreciation Dinner


Auxiliary Bishop Eduardo Nevares to be Honored for 40Years of Service


