APPLICATION DEADLINE AND SUBMISSION PROCESS:

• Funded applicants will be notified no later than April 15, 2023

REQUIRED APPROVALS AND SUPPORT DOCUMENTATION:

- Submitted application must include names and signatures from:
 - the school principal AND
 - at least one teacher who will be using the requested resource(s)

FUNDING INFORMATION: • Funding requests should not exceed **\$1,000.00 per teacher with a maximum of \$5,000.00 per school.**

Allowable mini grant examples include:

- The purchase of resources to support the teaching of students in your school with exceptional learning needs, to include: instructional materials, equipment, furniture, software, or other items that are not budgeted by your school.
- Scholarship assistance for teachers to attend any professional development conference, class or program that has a focus on improving a teacher's skills in areas to support exceptional learners/learners with disabilities, including, but not limited to, classes leading to special education teacher certification or degrees.

- Fees for any qualified service provider/consultant assisting with the success of one or more special needs students such as a behavioral specialist, speech/language, OT, Private Evaluator or Psych., etc.
