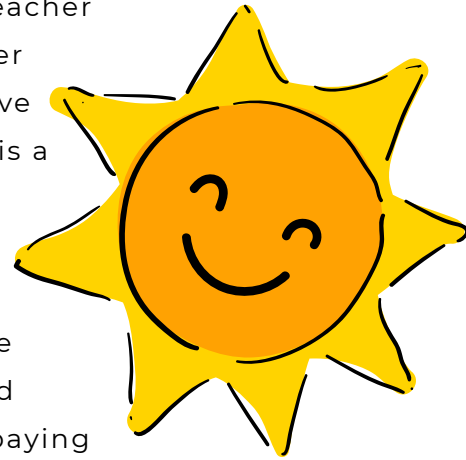

FUNDAMENTAL ELEMENTS OF SOUND

These core terms define the basic building blocks of any musical composition.

- **Pitch:** The highness or lowness of a musical sound, determined by its frequency.
- **Melody:** A sequence of single pitches arranged in a memorable, cohesive tune.
- **Rhythm:** The arrangement of notes and silences over time; it provides the song's pulse and "groove".
- **Harmony:** The blending of two or more different pitches played simultaneously to create a richer, fuller sound.
- **Timbre:** "tam-ber" Also known as tone color, this is the unique quality or texture of a sound that distinguishes different instruments or voices from one another (e.g., a bright piano vs. a reedy clarinet).
